The Distinguished Lecturer Selection Process

Two Distinguished Lecturers will be selected for each year from those recommended to the Distinguished Lecturer Committee. The selected Distinguished Lecturers will reflect a geographic balance to maximize the efficiency of delivering lecturers to interested audiences (e.g., European and North American Lecturers).

Candidates for Distinguished Lecturer must be:

- Willing to serve in the capacity of the ISES's Distinguished Lecturer and deliver two or more lectures during their two-year tenure.
- Active members of both ISES and the exposure scientific research community.
- Have experience and a good reputation in research and teaching related to exposure science.
- Willing to identify and communicate with institutions/organizations likely to invite an ISES Distinguished Lecturer.

Term of Commitment

The term over which the society will promote and subsidize speaking engagements for a Distinguished Lecturer is anticipated to be two years with additional time spent in advance to secure lecture invitations and allow the Lecturer time to organize speaking engagements.

Reimbursement

The award will consist of an announcement and publicity within the society of the award. The notice of the award will be posted on the ISES website.

ISES will ensure that the lecturer is reimbursed for travel costs associated with delivering lectures that have been approved (in advance) by the Distinguished Lecturer Committee. ISES may seek total or partial funding from the host institution. No stipend or honorarium will be given to the lecturer by ISES.
