Editor-in-Chief of the International Society of Exposure Science Publication: The Journal of Exposure Science & Environmental Epidemiology

The position of Editor-in-Chief (EIC) of *The Journal of Exposure Science & Environmental Epidemiology (JESEE)* will become available January 1, 2011.

JESEE, the official journal of the International Society of Exposure Science (ISES), is the premier journal publishing advances in the science of exposure analysis. Importance of exposure science to address current and emerging issues in global environmental and human health continues to increase as regulators, manufacturers, and the public seek ways to identify and eliminate chemical, physical, and biological exposures that harm sensitive humans and ecosystems.

A search committee has been appointed by the ISES to select a distinguished scientist to head this interdisciplinary journal on exposure science and environmental epidemiology. Candidates should have a Ph.D., M.D., or equivalent degree, and a comprehensive knowledge and understanding of the field of exposure sciences. In addition, candidates should have a distinguished research and publication record, high standing among peers, and prior experience in peer-review activities related to the publication of research in the field of exposure sciences or related disciplines.

The position involves coordinating reviews of submissions, making final decisions on manuscripts, producing editorials, etc. The appointment will be a five-year term, with potential reappointment for a second term. The EIC reports to the ISES Executive Board through the ISES Publications Committee and coordinates with this Committee and the publisher to select Associate Editors, the Editorial Board, and direct the future of the Journal. The successful candidate will work routinely with the Journal's publisher, Nature Publishing Group, on journal development to include raising the journal's profile to meet emerging needs for authoritative exposure science.

Telephone and/or personal interviews and the selection for the position will commence as soon as possible.
