The Department of Environmental and Occupational Health within the Robert Stempel College of Public Health and Social Work (RSCPHSW) at Florida International University (FIU) invites applications for two (2) tenure-track faculty positions at the Assistant, Associate or Full Professor level. The ideal candidates will be visionary individuals with a human health studies background who enjoy working in a highly interdisciplinary team environment. Excellent collaboration opportunities exist within the Department and throughout the RSCPHSW as well as with the Herbert Wertheim College of Medicine.

QUALIFICATIONS:

We are primarily interested in individuals with a strong academic record in research, teaching, and service in environmental health sciences; preferably focused on chronic public health effects of environmental toxicants on human populations and mechanistic studies. Research areas may include, but are not limited to, environmental pollution and human health, gene-environment interactions, and mechanisms of diseases associated with environmental factors. Candidates should have a Ph.D., M.D. or the equivalent and extensive experience in any of the following areas: (a) environmental epidemiology; (b) environmental toxicology; and (c) health impacts of air pollution, water pollution, or microbial toxins. We welcome candidates with experience in examining the molecular basis for the observed associations between environmental exposures and health, especially respiratory, cardiovascular, diabetes, reproductive or developmental, and cancer and model system endpoints.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The selected candidates will have the opportunity to participate in ongoing research with multidisciplinary researchers, and will be expected to develop and maintain an original, creative, and independent research program with evidence of high quality and productivity. This requires publications in high impact peer-reviewed journals and demonstrating the potential for successful submission and management of investigator-initiated grant proposals. Candidates will be expected to contribute to the educational mission of the Robert Stempel College of Public Health and Social Work through teaching and advising Master's and Doctoral students.

Academic rank will be determined by the qualifications of the candidate. Interested applicants should send a letter of application, including a statement of current and future research interests, curriculum vitae, sample publications; the names of four references; and if available sample grant applications and teaching evaluations.
