EPA's Office of Research and Development (ORD) is seeking an internationally recognized science leader to fill the position of Director for the Human Exposure and Atmospheric Sciences Division (HEASD) within the National Exposure Research Laboratory (NERL). This position is located in Research Triangle Park, North Carolina.

As the Division Director, the incumbent is recognized for his/her scientific leadership in human exposure research and will (1) develop, direct, and lead an interdisciplinary research program to understand and quantify human exposures to environmental contaminants; (2) develop and direct an interdisciplinary research program in atmospheric sciences to understand and describe the formation, fate, transport, removal of air pollutants and the exposure of humans and ecosystems to those pollutants; (3) provide scientific leadership to enhance coordination, collaboration, integration and communication of human exposure and atmospheric science research both within and outside of EPA; and, (4) communicate the outputs and impact of the research to EPA regulators, the scientific community, and the public. Activities will include managing and directing a highly technical and complex science research and development organization that has a nationwide impact and includes a staff of approximately 100 employees located in Research Triangle Park, North Carolina and Las Vegas, Nevada.

This position will be filled using EPA's Title 42 Authority, which allows us to hire the highest caliber science leaders through renewable term appointments of up to 5 years and at annual salaries of up to \$200,000 depending upon qualifications, experience, and other factors (e.g., current salary). The successful applicant must have a doctoral level degree in a pertinent science discipline and extensive specialized experience. The selected candidate will be eligible for full benefits including relocation, health and life insurance, retirement, and vacation and sick leave.
